Scott Bentley founded VideoRay in 1999. Prior to VideoRay, he was one of the first employees of Bentley Systems, Inc., an infrastructure software firm founded in 1985 which currently has nearly 3000 employees in 45 countries, with about \$500,000,000 in annual revenues. VideoRay is the dominant manufacturer of small observation class vehicles, with about 2000 units shipped. It is used throughout the world where portability, reliability, performance, and instrument integration are required for underwater investigation. Among the primary users utilizing VideoRay are governments and first responders; VideoRay is the standard remotely operated vehicle (ROV) for the United States Coast Guard, for example. It is also used by commercial divers, for offshore gas and oil production, and a host of other industries.

VideoRay is headquartered in Phoenixville, Pennsylvania. Mr. Bentley is the President of VideoRay and the majority owner. He graduated from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania in 1979.
